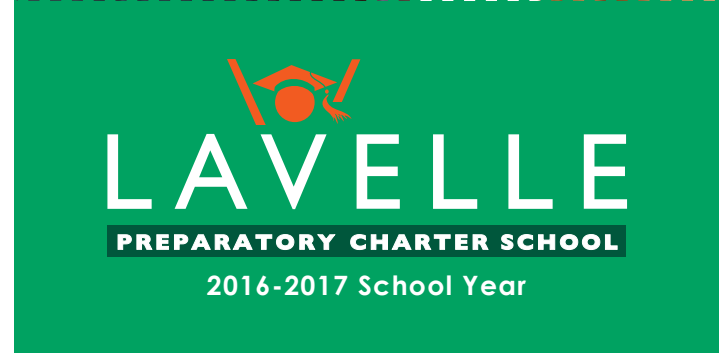

To ensure the mix of students essential to Lavelle Prep's success, separate lotteries will be conducted for Special Education and General Education students. Incoming third, fourth, fifth and sixth grade students are selected through a lottery, in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act. All applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list. A lottery for seventh grade will be held for placement on our waiting list. It is possible that no students will be admitted from the 7th grade lottery.



Eligibility, Application & Deadline

- Applications must be received by midnight on April 1st to be included in the lottery
- All children residing in New York State are eligible to attend Lavelle Prep
- Preferences will be given to siblings of current Lavelle Prep students
- Preferences will be given for students residing in CSD 31 (Staten Island)
- To qualify for Special Education lottery, student must have current Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- A separate application must be completed for each child
- Parents/guardians will be notified of acceptance at the lottery on April 18th 2016, and posted on our website by May 1st 2016

- Applicants not immediately selected will be added to a waiting list
